RE: USACE St. Lucie County Beach Erosion Project

Dear Colonel Kelly,

We are writing on behalf of our 5,000 plus South Hutchinson Island residents in St. Lucie County to respectively request your support and efforts concerning the above project.

We are grateful the 3.5 miles of the south St. Lucie County coastline on Hutchinson Island has been authorized for inclusion in the Federal 50-year Beach Preservation Program overseen by the USACE. Hopefully, you are familiar with the prospective "Initial Start" in early 2022 and the Corps' July 2021 contract signing deadline.

Important to developing a timely local funding plan and meeting the critical deadline is a better understanding of costs, about which there is much concern. Around Feb./Mar. 2019 the Corp's proposed contract for the project increased from approx. \$20.3 MM to \$22.8MM. This compares to a reported \$9.6MM supposedly all-inclusive total project cost (Corp Contract + non-Corp covered other local services & costs) for the 2018 Martin County 4-Mile Beach Project. The sand for both is similarly sourced from offshore and of comparable amounts (MC 427,000 vs SLC projected at 422,000 cubic yds). The north boundary of the MC project is the south boundary of the SLC project. The more than double prospective cost difference is hard for us to understand and makes funding plans a challenge.

Your inquiry on the proposed project costs and efforts on our behalf will be greatly appreciated. We hope for a successful path forward and thank you again for your support.

Thank you for your letter dated October 13, 2019, in which you request the Jacksonville District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) further describe the proposed project costs associated with the planned St. Lucie County, Florida, Coastal Storm Risk Management Project – South Segment. We recognize the importance of a better understanding of this information for the County to develop a timely local funding plan for this project.

Project cost increase from \$20.3M to \$22.8M: The cost increase is due to a delay in project construction from FY2018 price levels to projected FY2021 price levels.

Comparison to 2018 Martin County Shore Protection Project: The greatest difference between the Martin County and planned St. Lucie Project is the unit cost for sand. The Martin County project had an initial unit cost for sand of \$18.50/cy; however, a large contract modification of 162K cy of sand was added at a unit cost of \$7.54/cy. The unit cost for the additional quantity was negotiated with the contractor, which is atypical for a contract modification. The lower unit cost was due to the market conditions at the time, prior work commitments of the contractor and additional time provided to accomplish the work. The estimated unit cost of sand for the St. Lucie project is developed based on previously awarded similar construction projects and the actual production elements for the St. Lucie project.

Planning, Engineering and Design (PED) cost: Please note that the estimated PED cost for the St. Lucie project includes physical and biological monitoring requirements associated with pre- and post-construction, as well as the 18-year period between initial construction and the first planned renourishment. The monitoring cost makes up the majority of the estimated PED cost. Please also note that the \$9.6M cost for the Martin County project does not include physical and biological monitoring costs following the immediate post-construction surveys. Neither does it include real estate costs. A comparison of cost

components for an initial fill beach project and a renourishment projects are outlined in the table below.

Other costs: We confirmed that the estimated cost of real estate acquisition and processing was reasonable. We also confirmed that construction management cost were reasonable.


